Flip instructions over, box beam instructions located on opposite side of manual.

Step 1 Assembly

Separate the two drawer slides (B) by sliding each drawer slide (B) apart (1) and while pulling up on the black release lever (2) (located inside each drawer slide) separate the slide. When finished you should have 4 separate sections (3).

Step 2 Assembly

IMPORTANT: Make sure the bearing slides on the separated drawer slides are towards the **FRONT** of racking.

Attach the two separated drawer slides (B) "without black release levers" to the two drawer supports (A).

1. Slide the rear of the drawer slide (1) through the rear slot of the drawer support (A). Push back to secure.
2. Slide the front of the drawer slide (2) through the front slot of the drawer support (A). Push down to secure.
3. Repeat steps for second drawer slide.

Step 3 Assembly

Slide the assembled drawer supports (A-B) onto the inside bottom of the racking beams. Start by sliding the (1) side of (A-B) onto the inside beam edge. Finish by sliding (2) onto the second beam.

Step 4 Assembly

Attach the two cross supports (C) to the assembled drawer supports using 8 large screws (G) and 8 large nuts (H). Tighten the large screws (G) and large nuts (H) securely.

Step 5 Assembly

IMPORTANT: Make sure the black release levers on the separated drawer slides are towards the **BACK** of racking.

Attach the two separated drawer slides (B) "with black release levers" to the two drawer sides (D).

1. Slide the rear of the drawer slide (1) through the rear slot of the drawer side (D). Push back to secure.
2. Slide the front of the drawer slide (2) through the front slot of the drawer side (A). Push up to secure drawer slide.
3. Repeat steps for second drawer slide.

Step 6 Assembly

Attach the two drawer fronts (E) to the drawer sides (D-B) by sliding the drawer front (E) tabs into the holes provided on the drawer sides (D-B). Using a rubber mallet, tap on the outside corners of the drawer fronts (E) to secure.

Step 7 Assembly

Insert one drawer bottom (F) into the bottom of the drawer assembly.

Step 8 Assembly

Slide the drawer assembly onto the bearing guides located on the assembled drawer supports. Test to make sure the drawer moves smoothly. If necessary, loosen the large screws (G) and large nuts (H) from Step 4 and square up the assembly. Retighten and test the drawer again.

Enjoy your new drawer.

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



Step 1 Assembly



Separate the two drawer slides (B) by sliding each drawer slide (B) apart (1) and while pulling up on the black release lever (2) (located inside each drawer slide) separate the slide. When finished you should have 4 separate sections (3).

Step 2 Assembly


IMPORTANT: Make sure the bearing slides on the separated drawer slides are towards the **FRONT** of racking.



Attach the two separated drawer slides (B) "without black release levers" to the two drawer supports (A).


1. Slide the rear of the drawer slide (1) through the rear slot of the drawer support (A). Push back to secure.
2. Slide the front of the drawer slide (2) through the front slot of the drawer support (A). Push down to secure.
3. Repeat steps for second drawer slide.

Step 3 Assembly




Place the assembled drawer supports (A-B) onto the bottom of the racking beams. This is the position the drawer supports go for a fully boxed beam assembly. Move onto Step 4.

Step 4 Assembly



Attach the two cross supports (C) and four beam brackets (K) to the assembled drawer supports using 8 large screws (G) and 8 large nuts (H). Tighten the large screws (G) and large nuts (H) securely.


Step 5 Assembly



Insert four self tapping screws (L) into the beam brackets (K). Using a wrench or power drill thread the four self tapping screws into the two racking beams. Tighten the four self tapping screws (L) into racking beam to secure.

Step 6 Assembly


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Attach the two separated drawer slides (B) "with black release levers" to the two drawer sides (D).


1. Slide the rear of the drawer slide (1) through the rear slot of the drawer side (D). Push back to secure.
2. Slide the front of the drawer slide (2) through the front slot of the drawer side (A). Push up to secure drawer slide.
3. Repeat steps for second drawer slide.

Step 7 Assembly




Attach the two drawer fronts (E) to the drawer sides (D-B) by sliding the drawer front (E) tabs into the holes provided on the drawer sides (D-B). Using a rubber mallet tap on the outside corners of the drawer fronts (E) to secure.

Step 8 Assembly



Insert one drawer bottom (F) into the bottom of the drawer assembly.

Step 9 Assembly



Slide the drawer assembly onto the bearing guides located on the assembled drawer supports. Test to make sure the drawer moves smoothly. If necessary loosen the large screws (G) and large nuts (H) from Step 4 and square up the assembly. Retighten and test the drawer again. Enjoy your new drawer.
